

**PROFESSIONAL BOARD: UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT: AYURVEDA, CHINESE
MEDICINE AND ACUPUNCTURE, CHIROPRACTIC, THERAPEUTIC
AROMATHERAPY, THERAPEUTIC MASSAGE THERAPY, THERAPEUTIC
REFLEXOLOGY, OSTEOPATHY, UNANI-TIBB: INSTITUTION OF A DISCIPLINARY
INQUIRY: COMPOSITION OF INQUIRING BODY**

The Allied Health Professions Council of South Africa, after due consideration and in consultation with the Professional Board: Ayurveda, Chinese medicine and Acupuncture and Unani-Tibb (PBACMU), the Professional Board: Chiropractic and Osteopathy (PBCO), the Professional Board: Therapeutic Aromatherapy, Therapeutic Massage Therapy and Therapeutic Reflexology (PBARM), has resolved that, in terms of Regulation 19 of Regulations No.R.2610 of 3 December 1982, where either the PBACMU, the PBARM or the PBCO appoints a committee and delegates powers to such committee to act as an *inquiring body*, the said committee shall be composed of at least -

- (a) two public representatives, one of whom must be a chairperson;
- (b) two persons registered in the profession in which the respondent is registered, at least one of whom is registered in the same discipline as the respondent;
- (c) one member of the Council; and
- (d) one legal assessor.
