

# COMPOUNDING AND DISPENSING COURSE FOR ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS UJ

Subject to the provisions of section 22C of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, Act 101 of 1965 read together with Regulation 18 of the same Act, practitioners are required to apply for a Compounding and Dispensing Licence from the Director-General of the Department of Health.

The University of Johannesburg, Department of Complementary Medicine, has now been approved and accredited as a provider of “The Dispensing and Compounding Course for Allied Health Professionals”, by the South Africa Pharmacy Council.

The short learning programme (SLP) is structured as a 6-month online learning programme, comprised of five modules in the Dispensing component, and one discipline specific module for the Compounding component for Homeopaths and Chinese Medicine & Acupuncture (only).

There is one scheduled practicum. Once all modules have been successfully completed and a portfolio developed, practitioners will be required to complete a written assessment and practical examination (60% pass mark).

Registration for the short learning programme opens again on 10 May 2021; and the short course commences 1 June 2021.

A maximum of 30 candidates can be accommodated per SLP.
